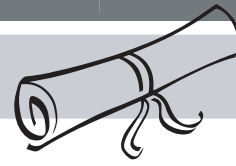

19th Graduation Ceremony Held at Youville

The Youville Centre's 19th graduation ceremony was held June 4th, 2009 at the M.F. McHugh Education Centre with 16 young women receiving their Ontario Secondary School Diplomas and 2 honorary graduates receiving recognition for obtaining acceptance to Algonquin College.

Graduation Day symbolizes a major milestone in the lives of our moms and their children as they embark on the next phase of their lives. The ceremony is a testament to the value and success of the Youville Centre and its goal of helping our young mothers realize greater independence and self-sufficiency.

Thanks are due, as always, to the families, teachers and staff, volunteers and donors who support our Centre throughout the year. Your dedication makes this special

day possible and also ensures our moms can continue once they have left Youville.

We are proud to say that 17 of our 18 graduates are entering college this fall. As well, the generous support from our donors has made it possible to award over \$20,000 in bursaries this year to our graduates, 11 alumnae who are continuing post-secondary studies and 3 children of former students entering post secondary programs.

Our graduating students have persevered under challenging odds to obtain their secondary school diplomas and should feel very proud that by succeeding they have opened doors to greater opportunities for their future and their children's future.
